

City Council Summary for February 16th, 2010

There were no business related agenda items.

Unfortunately, the agenda should be filled with items to move this city forward especially during these times. However, there were many updates that were discussed.

The council approved an amendment to the ordinance requiring removal of vehicles on streets during a snow emergency. We now have a 12 hour window from the time the snow emergency is called to remove our vehicles. The original ordinance had 0 hours.

Updates were as follows:

- Forensic Auditing firm will be chosen to come into the city to take a closer look at our books.
- The DPW investigating is in process.
- City Manager applicants will have interviews all day March 6th with a reception at the golf course to have a one-on-one with potential candidates.
- Appealing property taxes will be coming up in early March.
- PCB's is still under review for superfund, an open forum will be coming in the near future.
- Ambulance hardship criteria will be established to help those that cannot afford it.
- Rat abatement program will be on hold until a legal opinion will be drafted to clarify as to why the City is entering our private property.
