Welcome to the city of St. Clair Shores Ben Hughes, our new city manager!

There was a request to eliminate some no stopping, standing, parking signs on Revere Street from Jefferson to Greater Mack on Revere Street (Passed 5-0).

Also there was request to replace a police car that was totaled in a car accident. The city's insurance carrier covered the full price (Passed 5-0).

Ben Hughes updated news on DPW that we will learn in about 3 weeks the conclusion of the SCS police investigation results. In the mean time there is an Interim DPW director.

There was a change of order to not have anymore or very minimal requests put under the city managers report in order to have all requests on the agenda for the residents to view and discuss in an open meeting.

A contract was brought up that needed to be investigated between the city of St. Clair Shores and the city of Roseville on the sharing of their gym for an opportunity to use our pool.

The Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) and the \$1 HUD homes were the topic of major discussion. Mayor Hison commented on a request to sell a home as "micromanaging". Well, when it involves taxpayer dollars it is the responsibility of council to maximize profitability and to sell homes in the neighborhood to bring up home values.
