

Summary of St.Clair Shores City Council Meeting May 3, 2010

Proclamations & Presentations:

Congratulations to Tom Bugay, Shores Network for Action and Prevention (SNAP) recognizing “May is Drug and Alcohol Free Month in the City”, Wigs 4 Kids New Wellness Center Grand Opening June 5, 2010, Lake Shore Aria Winter Color Guard 2010 MCGC AA Champions.

The request for Planning Commission Case PC 10-02, approval of proposed activities for the 2010-2011 CDBG Program Year that was tabled from 4/19/10 council meeting. On the request from council the CDBG funds came back to fill a budget deficit at the Senior Center for the 2010/2011 budget year. Excellent work and **Council unanimously approved.**

Request for Approval of the Administrative Regulations. The agreement between City of St.Clair Shores and the department heads. It is just an agreement and not a contract, it is non-union. The human resource director who is part of this agreement was in front of council discussing his own contract. **Council unanimously approved to postpone** the agreement until further consideration is in place to control costs.

Council unanimously approved to postpone the request to approve the Activities Committee 2010 Fireworks. There was needed information to be given as to the costs of Police and DPW versus the amount of contributions that are received for the event.

Request approval to sales of the following \$1 HUD homes for 21230 Twelve Mile Road, 22511 Dorion, 29706 Taylor, and 22821 Lakeshore Drive were **unanimously approved by Council.**

Recommendation from the Communications Commission on the request to use the audio visual equipment in Council Chambers by residents. This is for the use of the overhead projector in the city council chambers by residents. **Unanimously approved by Council.**

Request from City Attorney for adoption to amendments regarding guns in the park. The City had an ordinance that guns were not to be in our parks; it was against Michigan Law, therefore it was **unanimously approved by Council** to allow guns in the park.

There was a request to set a Public Hearing on May 17, 2010 for the consideration of the creation of a Plant Rehabilitation District for land situated in the industrial district lying north of Kyte J. Monroe Park, generally known as the Fisher Dynamics Industrial Park and the former Plastech Products facility. **Unanimously approved by Council.**

Businesses requests were **unanimously approved by Council:**

One for a new sign in Central Lakefront District, by Phillips Sign & Lighting, for Achatz Burgers, 24605 Jefferson, petitioner Russell Achatz.

Nicke Enterprises, Inc. for a new Outdoor Service to be held in conjunction with the 2009 Class C licensed business located at 25020 Harper Ave.

Congratulations to a new business that will set up their facility in our city at 23000 Industrial Drive West for Site Plan approval for the construction of additional truck docks. **Unanimously approved by Council.**

Under Bids/Contracts/Purchase Orders:

Two are to be rescheduled; the request to award bid for 2010 Parks Mowing and Landscape Maintenance and the request to award proposal for Investment Management Services.

The one request was the approval of the consulting services contract with Plante & Moran for the collaboration of dispatch services. We are looking to move dispatch services into one building which will be in Roseville and to enter in with the cities of Eastpointe, Roseville, along with St.Clair Shores. There is a presumed cost savings if we do enter into the consolidation agreement. **Approved (6-1) 1-Rusie.**
