

Summary of the August 2, 2010 City Council Meeting

There was a presentation on the NSP program by a representative of the Michigan State Housing Development Authority. Listening in on the conversation about the program, the federal government surely made the decision to go forward with the business of home renovations with federal taxpayer dollars.

The modification to the collective bargaining agreement with the City and the Professional Employees Association PEA UAW Local 412 Unit 44 was again denied due to a less than 5% reduction. **Council Vote was 4-3, No-McFadyen, Hison, Frederick.**

Under the City Managers report there was the approval for the language of the Nov. 2 millage, **Council Vote 6-1, No-Frederick.**
